

Equipment Return Conditions

Capitalised words and phrases used in these Return Conditions have the same meaning as defined in the Rental Terms and Conditions agreed between Adaptalift Truck Rentals Pty Ltd (**ATR**) and the Hirer (**Agreement**).

Any Equipment supplied by ATR to the Hirer is required to be returned to ATR at the end of the Agreement:

1. In the same condition as which it was supplied (subject to Fair Wear & Tear)
2. To the Return Location where the Equipment was supplied or made available for collection, unless otherwise agreed in writing between the Hirer and Adaptalift Truck Rentals.
3. In a clean, tidy, and smoke free condition. Additional cleaning charges apply for Equipment returned:
 - (a) with excessive exterior grime, dirt or rubbish to the cabin, underbody or chassis
 - (b) requiring additional interior cleaning as a result of:
 - (i) Excessively soiled, or dirty cabin, seats, or mattresses;
 - (ii) Stains to the cabin, seats, or mattresses;
 - (iii) The removal of rubbish or leftovers from the vehicle or fridge;
 - (iv) The removal of strong odors or smells, including food, smoke, vape or tobacco from the vehicle or fridge.
4. With the same levels of fuel and ad-blue as the Equipment was filled to at the commencement of the Hiring Period. If the fuel levels are different, refueling charges apply.
5. Free of any Damage (subject to Fair Wear and Tear).
6. Free of any defects that would make the Equipment unsafe or non-compliant in a road worthy certificate (RWC) inspection or safety test.
7. Having been serviced, operated and maintained in accordance with OEM recommendations for the duration of the Hiring Period. This includes observing and complying with the requirements of any fault, servicing or warning indicators that may appear within the Equipment.
8. With all equipment and accessories supplied with the Equipment, including but not limited to:
 - (a) Keys, key fobs and any spare keys or key fobs supplied,
 - (b) A full tool kit including lifting jack, wheel braces and safety triangles,
 - (c) Fire extinguishers,
 - (d) Air lines, electrical and EBS leads,
 - (e) Manuals, log-books, maintenance records, inspection records and registration certificates

- (f) Spare tyres, lift out gates, and wheel chocks.
- 9. Without any Security Interest registered against the Equipment.
- 10. With no eTag, Linkt fob or other toll tracking device attached to the Equipment
